TDRA Remit

The TDRA remit will remain to be representing & promoting the interests of all residents living in the area, with a key focus on Turves village. It will also promote awareness & understanding of the impact of Fenland District Councils & Cambridgeshire County Council's policies as they affect residents.

New Residents

Welcome to all the new residents who have arrived in the village since the initial newsletter of November 2024.

Hub Update

In the last 18 months 11 villagers have worked together to achieve:

- The creation of Turves & District Residents Association
- Fenland District Council's recognition of the value of a pub in a community with it's granting of the status of Asset of Community Value (ACV). This gives the more than 200 yr old pub some protection from development
- Links with The Plunkett Foundation (our business advisors), the Pub is the Hub & the Campaign for Real Ale
- The registration of The Three Horseshoes Turves Community Hub Limited, as a Community Benefit Society, with the Financial Conduct Authority. This is a requirement to support the establishment of a community hub. Other Turves based matters remain within the TDRA's remit
- The **creation of business & financial plans.** These have been validated by the Plunkett Foundation & have been used with grant applications
- The drafting of plans for the creation of a five to ten acre community green space near the pub for which grants are being pursued
- An expression of interest to purchase the pub emailed to both the estate agent, & the owners. A response has not yet been received
- **Publicity across the region** on radio & TV, along with advertising in Discovering Whittlesey & Discovering March magazines raising public interest in our campaign.
- The submission of grants applications, with some awarded. There are others still at application stage. This includes some that will, if awarded, make purchase & renovation of the building possible. Details of grant applications, & awards, will be communicated in further newsletters

Hub AGM

The AGM was held in July of this year. The roles of Treasurer and Secretary remain the same while new members were elected into the following positions:

Moving forward, Stephen Goldspink, former chairman, will act as a project consultant.
